Open Mayor's Seat - No news.

Beach Rehab - DNREC has received approval of the design for the North Jetty. Project should be ready for bid by the end of January and contracts ready by the end of February. Construction will hopefully begin by early spring.

NEW BUSINESS

Collection of property taxes in arrears – Helena has received a listing from the tax collector of property owners in the town whose taxes are at least \$1,000 in arrears. After a short discussion, council decided that it would be in the best interest of the town to have the attorney begin taking the steps necessary to collect these outstanding monies.
