The regular meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm, September 10, 2015, by Vice Mayor Ada Puzzo.

Council Members present were: Ada Puzzo, Helena Hannah, Diane Yeisley and Bob McDevitt. Total in attendance was 24.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited in unison.

Ada Carter and Bob McDevitt were sworn in as Vice Mayor and Council Member respectively.

The minutes from the August meeting were read. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed to accept the minutes as read.

The treasurer's report was read. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed to accept the report as read.

Voter registration was available for all who have not yet registered.

**Committees:**

**Board of Adjustment:** The lawyers have not yet been able to settle with the property owners at 36 Bayshore. A hearing is pending.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**Bayshore Byways** – Ann Gravat and Karen Bennett attended the meeting with a presentation on this project and its goal of extending the existing Byway from Kitts Hummock to Lewis and how the Town of Bowers could benefit by participating.

**Drainage Project** – Mark reported that there will be a shortage of funds to complete this project as presently designed. Six of 16 necessary easements on North Bayshore have been signed. The Hubbard Avenue section of the project is moving forward. There are still a few easements that need to be signed for Outfall #2 on Cooper. The grant money that was awarded to the town for this project must be drawn on by August 15, 2018.

**Beach Replenishment and Jetty Work:** An on-site construction meeting was held on Sept. 8<sup>th</sup>; mobilization was scheduled to begin Sept. 10<sup>th</sup>; work is set to begin on Sept 21<sup>st</sup> and completed by April, 2016.

**Town Historical Marker** – Plans are moving forward. The town historian will be contacted to see if he would be interested in writing the verbiage for the sign.

**Leash Law Enforcement** – Pat brought in copies of new “Leash Law” signage. Bob will check on having these new signs made and posted in prominent locations in town.

**Phragmites Elimination** – Bob met with the Fire Marshall regarding the problem in town and has requested quotes from landscaping companies for perusal. There is a possibility that there will be Matching Funds Grant monies available. More information to follow.

**Reminder** - September 26<sup>th</sup> is the date for ‘Beer, Bocce and Bar-B-Que’ from 11-3 at the Bocce courts to benefit the museum.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

The Stop sign at Cross and Main needs to be repaired. Bob will handle.

The vegetation at the Northwest corner of N. Flack and Main needs to be trimmed back. It is overgrown and causing problems with visibility at that intersection.

Frenchie requested permission to remove three poles at the end of Cedar lane to allow access to the lane behind his property.

There being no further business, a motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:47 pm.
