

What else can I do to help prevent oil pollution?

- Check your vehicle for oil leaks and drips on a regular basis. When you find a leak, fix it promptly.
- Collect oil in containers with a tight fighting lid. Old milk jugs are perfect!
- Never dump motor oil, antifreeze or other engine fluids down the storm drain or into the ground.
- Wash your car at a car wash that filters water, this will prevent oil from you car to enter the ground water
- Use ground cloths under your vehicle whenever doing engine repair. Clean up all spills that happen in a timely manner.
